- 4. If you need to check out a PC from campus IRT, get that process started now.
- 5. Install the libraries using the posted installation guide, then test using the "Tumbling Cube" posted code.

Since the strike is officially over, I will resume responding to email and working on the course enrollment. However, I will probably not respond to emails tomorrow (Tuesday) because of my surgery.
